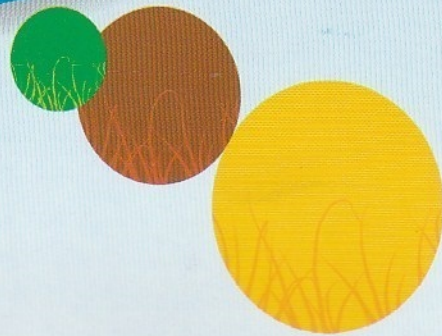

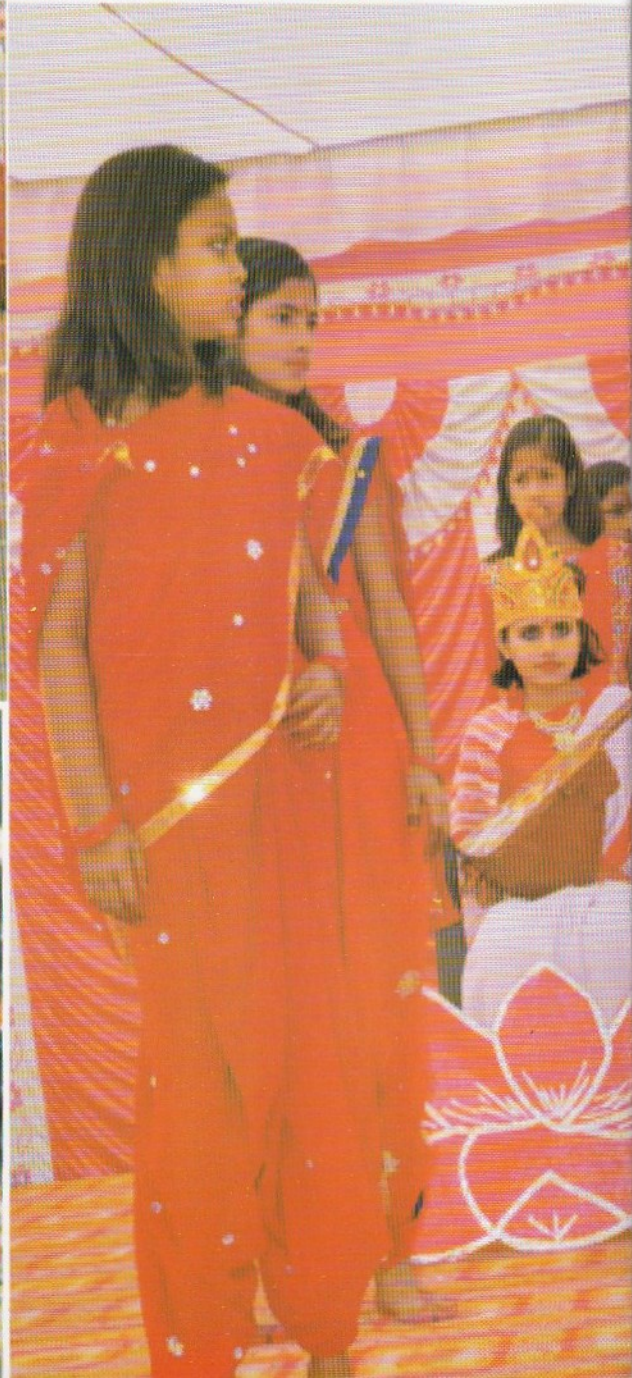

About the Academy

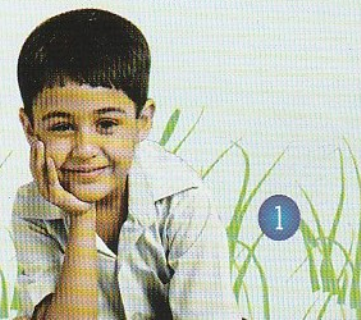

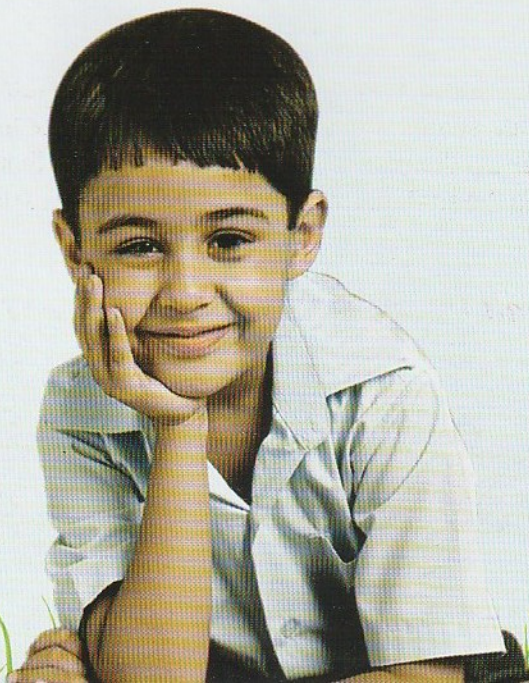


Dear Students,

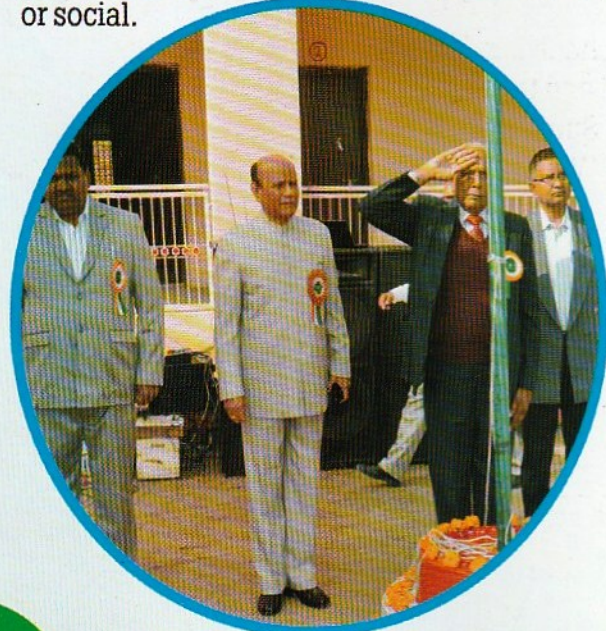
Vision

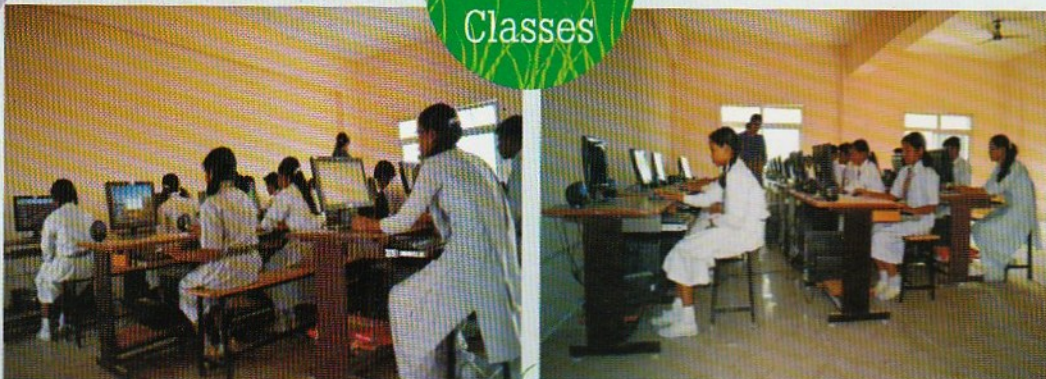


Mission

SESSION AND SCHOOL TIMING

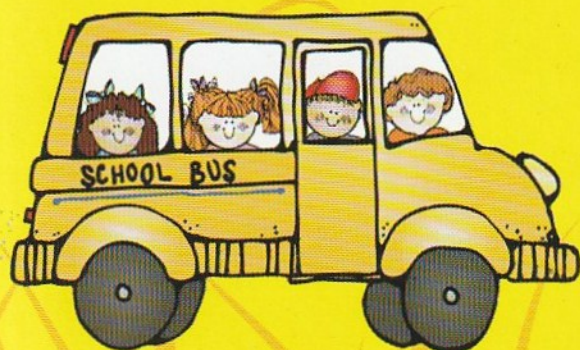
The school academic session starts from April to March, and the school timing is as given below.

TRANSPORT

- (i) The School provides facilities of transport by bus and van at reasonable rates.
- (ii) Withdrawal from conveyance facility must be preceded by a month's notice.
- (iii) Conveyance - Charge for Vacations will have to be deposited.



TEST AND EXAMINATIONS

There are IV FA and II SA Examinations in one academic year held by the Academy.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- (i) The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission to anybody without assigning reason for his action.
- (ii) No student may take private tuition in any subject from any member of the school.
- (iii) Damage to any school property has to be made recover by the guardians.
- (iv) The school does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, sex, ethnic background or national origin.

INSTRUCTION FOR STUDENTS

- (i) They must come to school in proper school uniform.
- (ii) They are supposed to reach the school ten minutes before the prayer bell.
- (iii) They ought to complete 80% attendance in an academic session.
- (iv) They must appear in all the examination conducted by the school.
- (v) They are allowed to converse only in English in the school premises.
- (vi) They ought to behave properly with their colleagues, Teachers & other staff of the school and must not damage school property or create nuisances in the school premises.

PARENTS TEACHERS MEET

Parents Teacher Meets are conducted for the overall development of the student and to check truancy. Meeting are conducted on predetermined dates for maximum response.



LABORATORY RULES

The School have well equipped laboratories to facilitate experimental work. The following rules are to be observed in these laboratories.

1. Equipment will be issued to the student as per rules laid down by the Principal.
2. No equipment is to be taken out of the laboratory without a written permission.
3. Any damage to the equipment during practical class will be borne by the students.
4. Any items issued must be returned before the commencement of the annual exam and a clearance certificate obtained from science teachers so as to enable the students to appear in the annual examinations.

LIBRARY RULES

1. Books will be issued and returned as per rules framed by the librarian.
2. Books will be issued for a definite period of time.
3. Only one book may be issued at a time.
4. A late fine of 50 paise per book will be charged daily until the book is returned.
5. The student should point out any damage to the books prior to getting them issued in his/her name otherwise he/she will be charged for the damage.
6. Tearing, writing, scribbling or folding of pages of books will be considered as damage done to books.
7. Students losing books or damaging them will be asked to pay the cost of the books.
8. All the library books issued to the students must be returned before the commencement of the annual examination and clearance slip must be obtained from the library to appear in the examination.

SCHOOL TOURS

Educational tours, to the destinations of historical, cultural and industrial importance to the world over, are organised during the breaks.

PARENT CO-OPERATION

1. Parents are required to look in to their child's school diary every day and see that the lessons countersigned by the parents.

and the homework assigned for the next day are done regularly.

2. If you feel that your child is not making the desired progress, please make it a point to discuss it with the Principal and class-teacher inside the school office only.
3. Criticism of the child Student's teacher his/her school in the presence of the child should be avoided because it may cause the student to lose respect for his teacher and the school.
4. Parents are not allowed to meet their children or their teacher during school hours without prior permission of the principal.
5. Parents are requested to inform the school of any change of address and phone number.
6. (a) Parents are requested to send their children to school on time.
(b) Presence of every child in the assembly is compulsory.
(c) The child who fails to reach the school on time and does not attend the assembly may be sent back home.
(d) Parents should not take the child without prior permission to the principal during school days.
(e) No sick child may be sent to school with medicines during school hours.

SUGGESTIONS FOR PARENTS

- (i) They should interact with the school authority time to time for all round development of their children.
- (ii) They must pay school fee in time and help in the development in the school without any hindrance.
- (iii) They should go through the school diaries of their children everyday and ensure that they complete their home works regularly without fail.
- (iv) They must go through report cards supplied to their children after every examination and contact authority in charge to remove inefficiency it found in their Children.
- (v) They should contact the authority in charge during visiting hours only.
- (vi) If their children are reading in Nur., KG, UKG, Std. I or II they must prove as a Guardian /Parent before taking them back home.

ATTENDANCE, ABSENCE, FINE AND READMISSION FEES

1. As regular attendance is an important requirement for successful results, a written application for leave must be submitted well in advance. In case of illness and other unforeseen circumstances, the guardians should inform the Principal in writing as soon as possible. A minimum attendance of 90% of the total working days is required during the academic year, falling short of which the student will not be allowed to take the examination in that every year.
2. The name of a student who is absent for 15 days without leave shall be struck off the roll. On readmission a readmission fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged. Rs. 1.00 per day will be charged as absence fine.
3. A student whose name has been struck off for absence without leave and who is habitually late or persistently careless or indisciplined may not be re-admitted to the school.
4. Every student must be present on the reopening day after each vacation.
5. It is advisable to ensure that a student is not disturbed during examination day and is not asked to attend family functions.
6. No student can leave the school premises during school hours without the written permission of the Principal, which may be granted under exceptional circumstances, based on written request of parents.
7. The Principal has the right to suspend a student. The Principal may also ask parents/guardians to withdraw their child from the school if his/her conduct on educational progress is not satisfactory.
8. All entries of absence, late coming and half day leave should be made in the school diary and not on sheets of paper.

LEAVE

- (i) A student can not avail leave for more than 2 days in a month and 20 days in a year.
- (ii) No leave other than medical leave is sanctioned during exams provided a medical certificate from a medical authority is submitted.

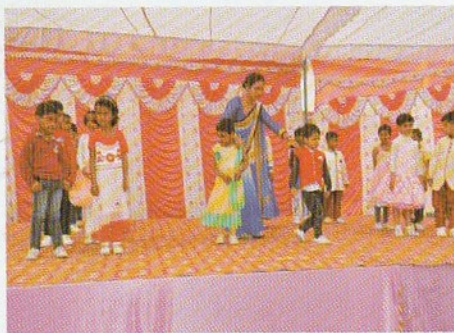
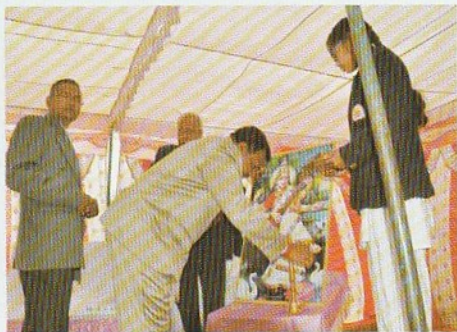

Admission Procedure

The school admits only after the child is found eligible after test for the class applied strictly on the basis of merit only. please read the points as given below-

1. For 1st standard the student's age must be up to 5 years.
2. For admission parents have to fill up a registration form which is available at the school counter.
3. The dates for the entrance test and the management - parents interface will be notified at the of submission of the registration form.
4. The registration fee is non refundable. Registration does not imply admission.
5. The admission is subject to availability of seats, the student's performance in the entrance exam and other related procedure.
6. The prospective student from 1st onwards will have to appear for an entrance exam consisting of questions to test his knowledge of Hindi, Maths, English and general studies as per the requirement of the class for which admission is sought.
7. List of the successful candidates are put on the school notice board as per the dates specified.
8. Once the candidates is successful in the admission test, the other formalities to be completed are :
 - a. payment of all fees within the due dates.
 - b. Submission of proof of date of birth for students.
 - c. Submission of Transfer Certificates in original in case of admission from class II onwards.
 - d. Once the admission fees is paid it will not be refunded under any circumstances.







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
